As a **Drop-In Group Volunteer**, you will offer emotional support as part of a hospital-based support drop in for birthing partners.

Your role may include:

- Engaging in conversation with birthing partners who are attending The group
- Providing emotional support for attendees
- Setting up for the session's activities and tidying up at the end
- Providing refreshments for group attendees

We're looking for someone who is:

- A good active listener.
- A warm, friendly and enthusiastic volunteer, happy to get stuck in
- Able to communicate well with a wide range of people.
- Comfortable offering support to those experiencing emotional situations.
- Able to work both independently and as part of the team.
- Non-judgemental
- Able to follow instructions to be safe at all times.

Your commitment:

- Our support groups take place regularly and we are looking for volunteers able to support on a regular basis – this group runs every other week on a Thursday from 5-7pm and you are welcome to attend each session, or alternate sessions
- To enable you to get the most of your training we ask that you are available to volunteer for a minimum of 12 months

Training and Support

- A dedicated member of Rainbow Trust staff will guide and support you in your work.
- You will be supported through a full induction to the charity and training relevant to your role, to help you get the most from your time with us.
- Training will cover areas such as safeguarding, active listening skills,
